As can be seen by the tremendous variations in numbers of pecan per pound, it is difficult to draw any conclusions on effectiveness of fungicides. The pecans are all different sizes due to environmental factors. Trees were stressed.

Leaf and nuts did not show any signs of scab throughout the year. This was a pathologist nightmare trying to make this trial work. We will try again next year.

All treatments applied 4-13, 4-27, 5-11, 6-8, 7-6, 8-10.
